- 1985 Initiation of Health Services Research in Switzerland: Programme «Recherches et réalisations en médecine appliquée» (RRMA) (annually funding of CHF 200' 000.- for research in primary care)
- 2011 Gottfried and Julia Bangerter-Rhyner Foundation funding the programme „Health Services Research“, accompanied by the SAMW
- 2013 Bundesrat launched the Agenda „Health 2020“ with the aim to „strengthen Health Services Research in Switzerland“.
- 2015 NFP 74 „Gesundheitsversorgung“
